

LONDON, STONEHENGE, BATH, AND SCOTLAND in 7 days

March 15, 2025: Overnight flight to London- Join your group at your Florida airport for your overnight flight to London.

March 16: Welcome to London – Meet your Exploring Europe guide after clearing immigration, baggage claim, and security. Today, enjoy an orientation of London! We'll begin with a visit to the Burrough Market, London's premier daily outdoor food market hall, where you can choose and purchase your lunch menu. Then, walk along Bankside, passing Shakespeare's Globe and the National Theatre. Enjoy a spin on the London Eye for a bird's eye view of Westminster, the Thames, and London City. Later, let's head to our hotel for check-in and time to settle in. Tonight, we'll walk to dinner at a neighborhood pub. *Sleep for 3 nights in London. Dinner*.





March 17: London Sightseeing – A local Blue Badged guide will join you for a full day of sightseeing. Today, transportation will be on foot and via the London Underground. Visits this morning include Westminster Abbey and viewing the Guard Change at Buckingham Palace. We will stop near Leister Square, where you can enjoy some free time for lunch, a visit to Trafalgar Square, and shopping at Piccadilly Circle. Later, visit the Tower of London, home of the British Crown Jewels, with your local guide.

Then, let's head to Covent Garden for an early dinner, followed by a West End Theatre performance. *Dinner*.





March 18: Stonehenge & Bath – Today, enjoy a trip to the countryside and the rolling hills of Salisbury. Visit Stonehenge, where 2700 years ago, ancient people erected huge stones for religious celebrations.

Then, we'll visit the Georgian city of Bath and explore the bathing facilities built by the Romans in the 1st century A.D. Returning to London, enjoy a free evening and dinner on your own.

March 19: Edinburgh – Today, enjoy a train trip through England as we travel to Edinburgh. This afternoon, we will walk along the Royal Mile and the Georgian "new" town. Then let's have dinner together at a neighborhood restaurant. We'll cap off the evening with a historical "ghost" tour, visiting the caves and dungeons below the old town. *Train:* 5 hours. Sleep for 3 nights in Edinburgh. Dinner.





March 20: The Highlands – Enjoy a full-day adventure in the Highlands. You'll visit the Caledonian Canal and the rugged Glen Coe, with sweeping vistas of Scotland's highest peak, Ben Nevis. Approaching Lock Ness, keep your eyes peeled for its famous monster, Nessie. Then, we'll board our ship to cruise along the loch and visit the ruined Urquhart Castle. Back in Edinburgh, enjoy dinner together in our hotel neighborhood. *Dinner*.

March 21: Edinburgh – Let's head to Edinburgh's harbor and step aboard the Royal Yacht Britannia. A Royal residence for over 40 years, The Royal Yacht Britannia sailed the seas with the Royal Family on state visits and entertained prime ministers and presidents worldwide. You'll have the afternoon to do more exploring around Edinburgh. Tonight, we'll cap off your tour with a grand farewell dinner. *Dinner*.

March 22: Your tour ends today. After breakfast, we'll head to Edinburgh Airport for your flight home.
